There are various ways to obtain forklift training. Programs are offered through workforce training agencies, company forklift certification programs, and approved online and video programs. The price could be minimal (or free) when provided through employment agencies or by occupational safety officers on job sites.

Forklift operators should be 18 years of age or over, in most countries. Local industry bodies approve Loader Training courses and need operators to obtain a certificate before using this kind of heavy machinery. A certificate is valid for four years in nearly all areas. Businesses that hire employees to drive lift truck trucks can face serious liability issues if operators fail to keep this certificate up to date.

Untrained forklift operators could lead to property damage and serious injury due to improper utilization of the machine. Training covers the correct driving and loading techniques. Workers need to pass a written test in order to be certified. A company would normally designate a supervisor to provide hands-on training to new employees. A qualified supervisor should have extensive training in lift truck safety and be licensed as a trainer.
