### Introduction

Warehouse operations that are efficient and orderly tend to be safer and more successful. It is necessary for the worker to move and store the goods throughout the facility in a timely and efficient way. Due to the various activities involved in warehouse operations, staff in warehouse environment may be at greater risk for accidents as opposed to individuals who work in areas with more limited activities. Thus, businesses prioritize warehouse safety.

Knowledge of potential warehouse hazards is important to avoiding accidents. Always be alert to possible dangers and methods to lessen risks. Do whatever is necessary to avoid accidents.

### General Hazards

Common kinds of danger in a warehouse setting are falls, slips and trips. These accidents are often caused when staff lose their balance or stumble over a thing that has not been put away correctly. Removing or placing things from storage can result in a fumble or slip, potentially causing both item and employee to fall. The potential for falls, slips and trips is increased when workers are moving supplies on various kinds of floor surfaces and on various levels. One more common danger is getting hit by falling items. This is normally caused by failure to correctly stack items on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries due to incorrect lifting methods are one more common danger.

There are inherent risks in using and working around workplace machinery. Accidents could often be caused from the incorrect use of hand trucks, forklift trucks and conveyors. Warehouse tools, like pallets, skids, cutting and strapping tools, must be used carefully during loading, packing and unpacking.

Materials that are dangerous, flammable or combustible present another kind of workplace hazard while being stored in a warehouse. Staff must know how to take steps to protect themselves from health dangers while working around hazardous materials.
