Burlington Aerial Lift Ticket - Boom trucks are often used by phone, cable television and utilities companies as they have long folded arms which are commonly folded over the roofs of company vans. On the end of the extension of extendable arms usually sits a bucket-like apparatus. When a container truck has an extendable boom mounted the roof this is sometimes identified as an "aerial boom truck" or a "cherry picker". It is capable of transporting employees to the top of a telephone or electrical pole. Bucket boom vehicles have a hauling capacity of roughly 350 lbs to 1500 lbs or 158 kg to 680 kg plus they are able of extending the bucket up to 34 feet or just over 10 meters into the air.

Heavy equipment boom vehicles or construction boom trucks may have a hoist attached to the rear. These cranes often called knuckle booms might be short and compact or be of the trolley boom variety, where the crane is able to extend the length of the vehicle bed. Hoist boom vehicles possess a hauling capacity between 10 to 50 tons or about 9 to 45 metric tons.

Concrete boom trucks are a further adaptation. The booms on these lift trucks have a tube with a nozzle at the far end and are utilized to pump concrete or other resources. The areas where these materials need to be deposited is usually inaccessible to the vehicle or is stationed at a great height, for that reason, the boom of a larger concrete boom truck might be extended 230 feet or roughly 71 meters. The vehicle then pumps the concrete through the boom precisely depositing it into the space where it is needed.

Fire departments are outfitted with a lengthy container boom employed to raise firefighters to the high floors of a building. Once in place, this boom allows them to direct water onto flames or to rescue trapped victims. A lot of of the older hook and ladder trucks have been replaced with contemporary boom trucks.

There is also a miniature self-propelled boom vehicle, related to a forklift that is offered on the market for sizable warehouses or manufacturing facilities. These mini boom trucks may lift workers to upper storage areas or to the ceiling of the building. They are much safer and more durable than utilizing an extension ladder for the equivalent application.
