The limits and abilities of the machinery are included, together with pre-operation inspections, fundamental operating measures and methods of warning other personnel that a forklift is in the work site.

Lessons comprise the placement of the chock blocks and trailer tires, the arrangement of pallets to be able to spread out the load right, and checks required before driving into a trailer at a dock site. Courses likewise consist of Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) training. Though not related directly to the utilization of a forklift, MSDS training is essential in case an operator notices a leaking container or damages a container containing toxic materials. MSDS sheets list the products, their effects on individuals and right methods of dealing with spills.
